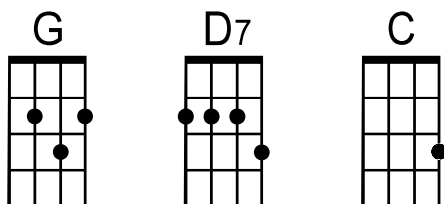


## I Am a Pilgrim Traditional
